Detours planned for State Highway 19 in Watertown

MINNEAPOLIS – As a result of work on the railroad bridge over Highway 19 on Watertown’s west side, road traffic will be subject to detours for three weeks starting April 11. Motorists using Highway 19 between Dayton and Hiawatha streets should consider alternate routes. The pedestrian tunnel will remain open during the construction period.

The road closure is necessary so that CP’s engineering department can rehabilitate a bridge component that is nearing the end of its service life. CP anticipates completing work and reinstating normal traffic flows by April 29. All through traffic will be subject to the detour, while residents of West Main Street west of the overpass to Dayton Street will be able to access their properties.

Safety will be CP’s top priority while this bridge undergoes work.
